**Determination of the Challenges to Petitions
2019 Democratic Primary
by the Office of the Camden County Clerk**

On April 4, 2019, William M. Tambussi made an objection to the following petitions:

- Joint Petition of Jennifer O'Donnell & Jerome A. Taylor, Sr. for Freeholder for the validity of the entire set of petitions because of alleged "violations of law committed in circulating, verifying and submitting" petitions by candidate Taylor.

On April 5, 2019, Judith Amorosa made objections to the following petitions:

- Joint Petition of Amanda Semple & Jason A. Witte for Freeholder for candidates' names not "printed on the front of the petition".
- Joint Petition of Steven Panarello & Randall J. McGinnis, Jr. for Freeholder for the candidates not being "registered voters who are affiliated with the Democratic Party" and an "insufficient number of valid signatures".
- Joint Petition of Dori Larm & William Efmow for Freeholder for an "insufficient number of valid signatures".
- Joint Petition of Mohammad Kabir for County Clerk for an "insufficient number of valid signatures".

The County Clerk's Office has reviewed the objections to the petitions and have made the following determinations:

Joint Petition of Jennifer O'Donnell & Jerome A. Taylor, Sr. for Freeholder

With advice from County Counsel, the petition of Jennifer O'Donnell & Jerome A. Taylor, Sr. for Freeholder is rejected in its entirety as it has been found and confirmed by a Law Enforcement Agency investigation that there were signatures that were ill-gotten on the petitions circulated, verified and submitted by Candidate Taylor. Please note that between the time the objection was filed and this determination, Candidate Taylor has withdrawn his nomination and a new candidate, Michael Lovett, has replaced via the committee on vacancies. The replacement does not cure the petitions.

Joint Petition of Amanda Semple & Jason A. Witte for Freeholder

The petition set in question is one of several petitions that were all circulated by the same witness, Candidate Semple, and were accepted as one group. As such, it is determined to be valid.

Joint Petition of Steven Panarello & Randall J. McGinnis, Jr. for Freeholder

Candidates Steven Panarello and Randall McGinnis are registered as members of the Democratic Party per the New Jersey Statewide Voter Registration System. After a review of the challenged signatures, it has been determined that there are 107 valid signatures. The required number of signatures is 100. As such, this petition is determined to be valid.

Joint Petition of Dori Larm & William Efymow for Freeholder

After a review of the challenged signatures, it has been determined that there are 96 valid signatures. The required number of signatures is 100. As such, this petition is determined to be invalid.


Joint Petition of Mohammad Kabir for County Clerk
